PRODUCT CARE & MAINTENANCE

Manufactured from 100% genuine pewter, the Finesse range of ironmongery is not only extremely robust but also has fantastic anti-corrosion properties - achieving BS EN 1670:2007 Grade 5 in independent testing. The products stunning, natural finish should not be confused with cheaper alternatives - often called pewter 'effect' or 'patina' - whereby a cheaper base metal has been coated to mimic the effect of genuine pewter.



PEWTER

Over time, genuine pewter develops a natural patina. To maintain the products original finish, we recommend cleaning Finesse ironmongery with warm soapy water every 3 to 6 months. If left longer and pewter begins to darken, apply a light coat of non abrasive metal polish such as Brasso and, when dry, buff vigorously to a shine.

WOOD

Our Milton and Eden range of Oak and American Walnut door and kitchen handles should be cleaned with a clear wax polish.

LEATHER

Our Jarrow and Jedburgh range of leather door handles and kitchen hardware is best cleaned with a damp cloth.
